HSE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

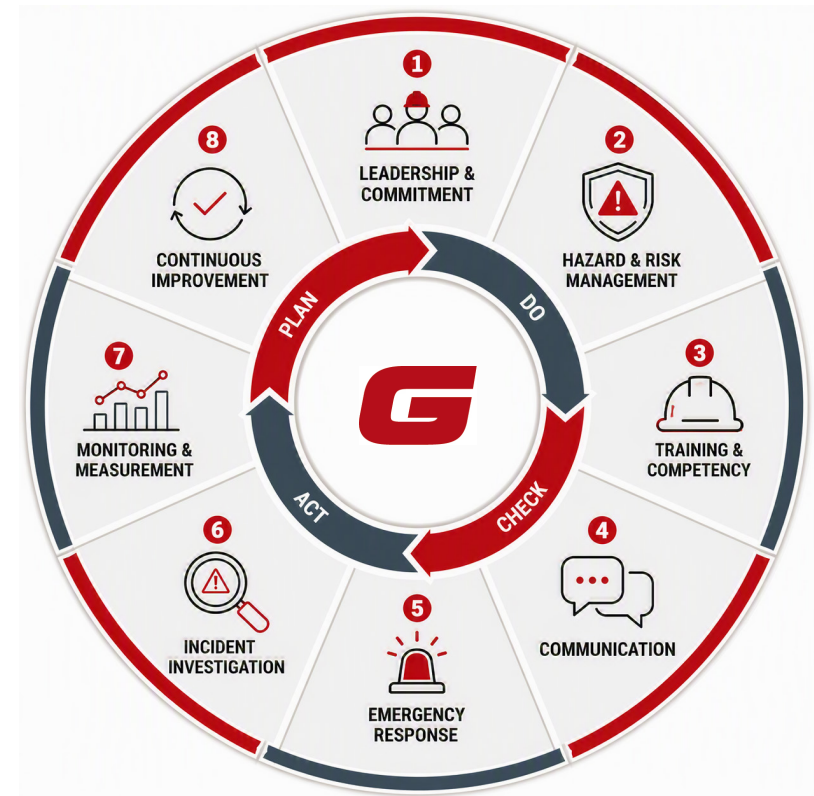

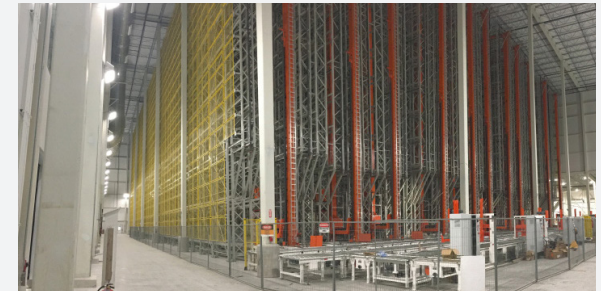

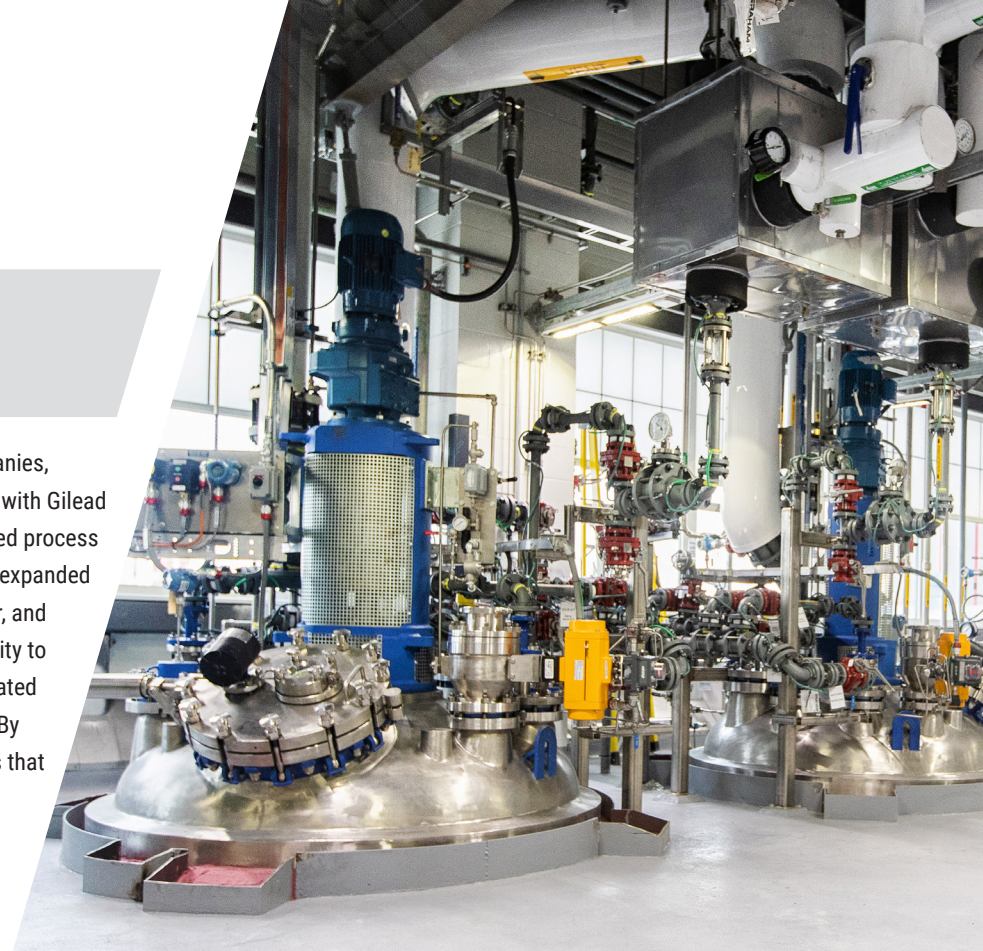
